GLASGOW · OBAN

DAY 1. ARRIVAL



DAY 2. OBAN

Visit the historic Oban Distillery, one of Scotland's oldest, founded in 1794, and enjoy an exclusive tour and tasting*. Explore the beauty of Royal Deeside with a morning visit to Crathes Castle and its stunning gardens. Stroll through the charming village of Ballater, known for its royal warrant shops. Meet a local farmer to learn about the iconic Highland Cattle and sample delicious regional specialties.* **Overnight: Aberdeen**
